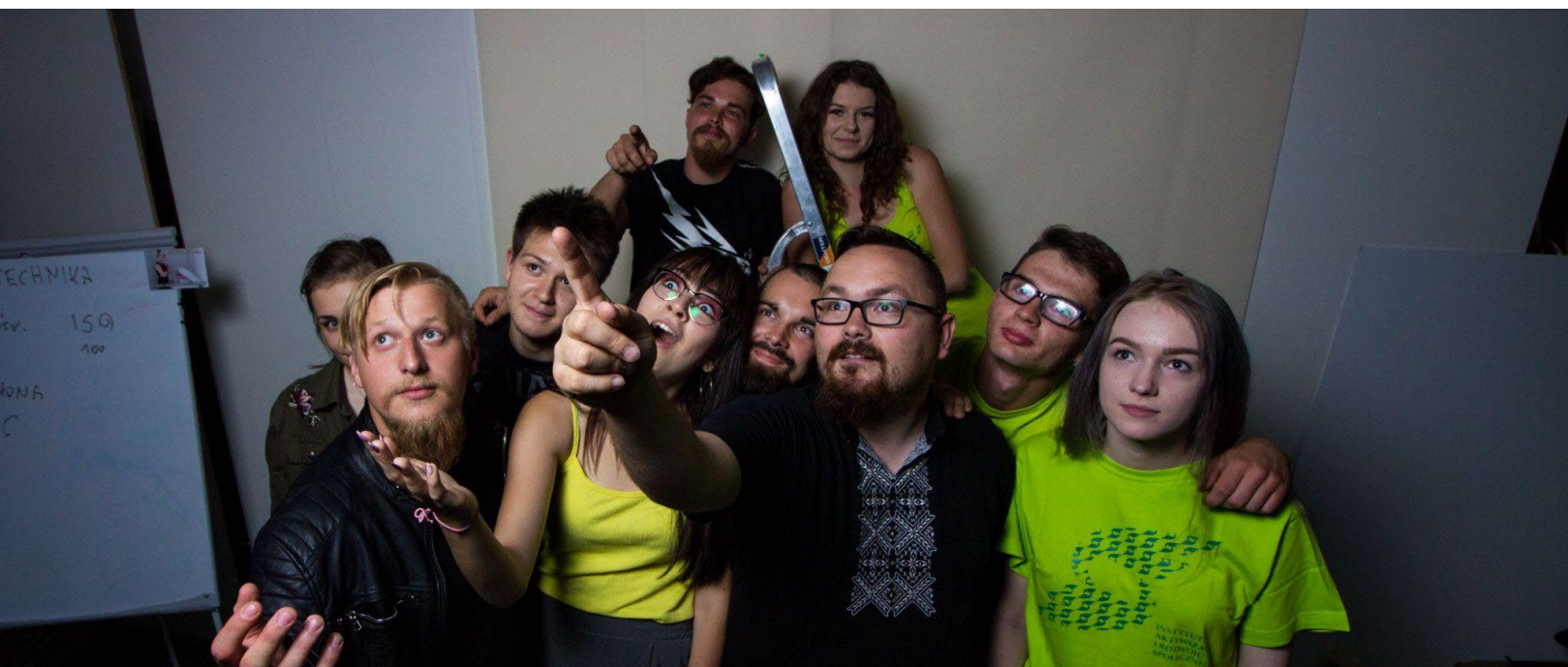

43 youth workers from 8 countries: Romania, Hungary, Poland, Spain, Italy, Lithuania, Bulgaria and Portugal will take part in the seminar.

The aim of the project is, based on the experience of the Pandemic that we have faced, to prepare together and develop standards / ideas / opportunities to work with young people in crisis situations. These realities affected not only third sector organizations, but schools, nurseries, cultural institutions, care and educational institutions, etc. Through a 7 day contact seminar, we want to develop methods of operation, methods of working with young people on a continuous basis even in a situation that requires us to work remotely.

The main bus station "Dworzec Główny PKS" is close to the hostel, so you can walk on foot. Getting from the main train station "Dworzec Główny PKP" to the hostel requires you to also take the city bus.

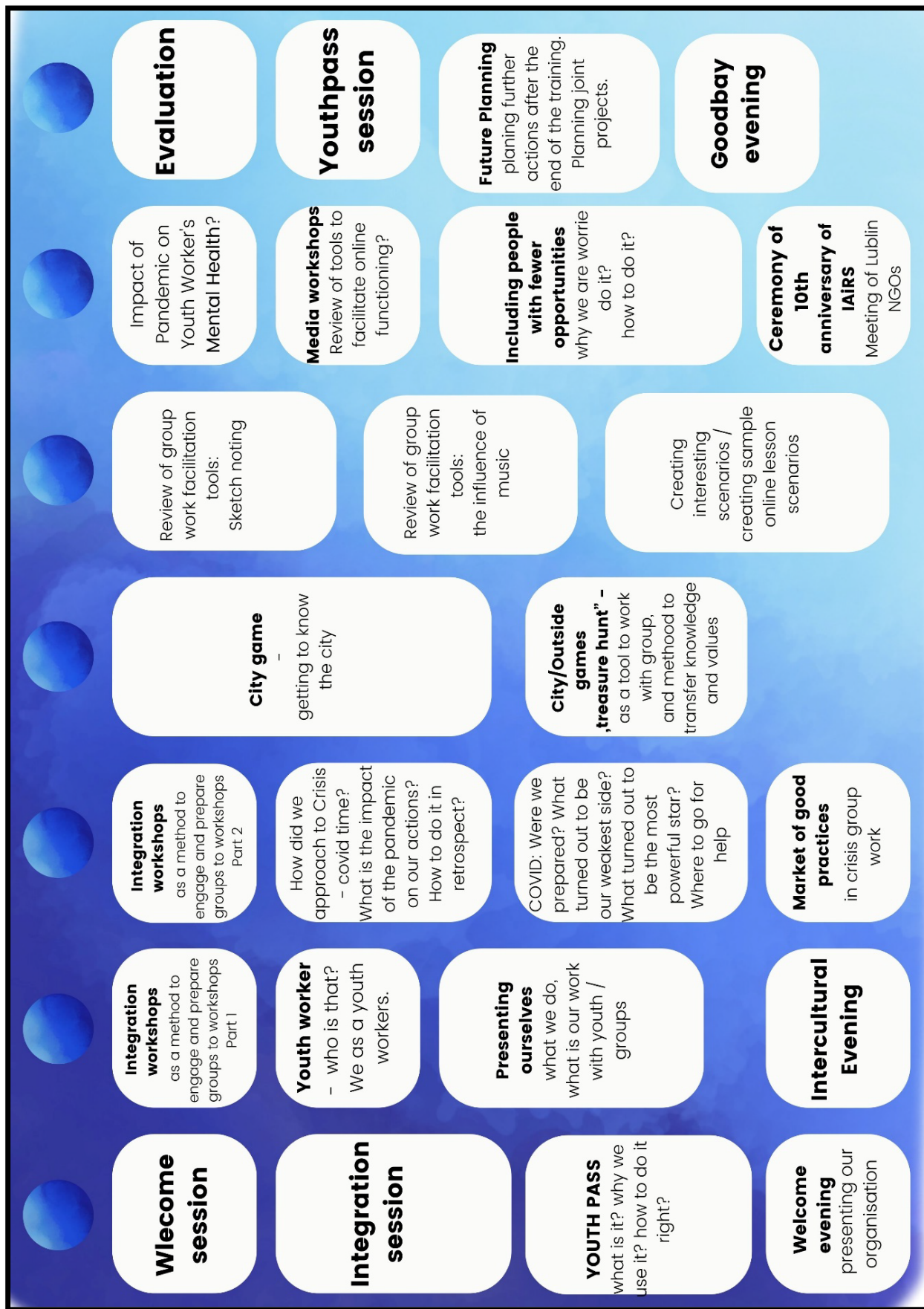
### Rules for travelers coming to Poland

- Travelers are quarantined unless they test negative for COVID-19. The test will have to be performed no earlier than 48 hours before crossing the border.

- Type of test: PCR or antigenic.
- The solution will cover all means of transport: public and individual transport as well as pedestrian crossing of the border.
- Travelers who have been quarantined in Poland will be able to perform a test within 48 hours of crossing the border, the negative result of which will release them from quarantine.

Important! People vaccinated against COVID-19 are released from quarantine. This applies to people who have been issued a certificate of vaccination with a vaccine that has been authorized in the European Union. Full vaccination in the European Union will be accepted 14 days after the end of the vaccination process.

## REIMBURSEMENT
